Dave was involved with flood mitigation work in Boggs Township, securing FEMA funding to repair road culverts damaged by the heavy rains that fell on Centre County in October 2016. Dave is also involved with projects for the Dirt, Gravel, and Low Volume Road, (DGLVR) program. He submitted several projects under the DGLVR program, with two projects approved for funding and construction scheduled for Spring 2018.
