

## Boggs Township Board of Supervisors

Special Meeting  
October 23, 2018

The October 23, 2018 special meeting of the Boggs Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Boggs Township Municipal Building, 1270 Runville Road, Bellefonte, PA. Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was observed. Present were Supervisors David Veneziano, Terry Gates and Glenn Coakley, Zoning Officer/UCC Administrator Jeffrey L. Williams, Solicitor Rodney Beard and Secretary/Treasurer James Strunk.

### Public Comment:

1. Celia Hockenberry 115 Sno Fountain Drive and William & Linda Trefelner 114 Sno Fountain Drive - Discussion was held concerning Celia Hockenberry's formal complaint against the Trefelner's for having an unpermitted shed on their property and an unapproved facility in that shed that is used as a urinal with a hose running outside into the ground. Zoning Officer Williams said the shed was properly permitted. Williams reported that he has talked to DEP about this issue and they turned it over to Stan Wallace our SEO. Wallace told Williams that the area is in a public sewer system and it should be MCCA problem. MCCA told Williams that they do not have jurisdiction over this. Williams said anything to do with the sewer system would have to fall back to the owner off Sno-Fountain Mobile Home Park, M&M Residential Rentals, Matt & Meghan Kremser. Williams stated that the tube does not run onto the ground it goes into a pit dug about 12'' deep and is filled with gravel. Mrs. Hockenberry stated that when she spoke to Stan Wallace he felt her complaint was justified but he said he could not get involved until the Boggs Township Supervisors made a decision. Williams stated that when he spoke to Wallace he would get involved if the Supervisors directed him to do so. Williams stated he spoke to the Trefelner's and if this is an issue they would remove this from their shed. Mr. Trefelner approached the Supervisors and showed them pictures on his cell phone of both the inside and outside of the shed showing his "crude" system (this is Mr. Trefelner's description of the system). Supervisors will contact Stan Wallace SEO on this and then create a formal response to both parties.
2. Hazel Davidson, 160 Holter's Crossing Road - Questioned what was being done on Eagle Cemetery Road. Driving Surface Aggregate is being placed thru a Dirt & Gravel grant.

### Administrative Actions:


