

Boggs Township Board of Supervisors

Regular Meeting

March 7, 2023

The March 7, 2022 regular meeting of the Boggs Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Boggs Township Municipal Building, 1270 Runville Road, Bellefonte, PA. Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was observed. Present were Supervisors David Veneziano, Terry Gates, Glenn Coakley, Solicitor Rodney Beard, and Zoning Officer/UCC Administrator Jeffrey L. Williams.

Public Comment:

1. Ralph and Vicki Catherman – asked about the clean-up status of the Packer property. Solicitor Beard presented pictures of the property. He explained next steps. First step to get property owner to clean up property with progress made by April 4, 2023. If clean up progress is not made by April 4, 2023, second step will be to file with the court to get a court ordered clean up. Motion by Gates 2nd by Coakley to get a clean-up agreement with Mrs. Packer with progress by April 4, 2023.

Staff Reports:

Zoning Officer – Jeff Williams gave his report for February 2023. Building and zoning activity in the township has slightly increased in February. He has several issues that need to be followed up, (roaming animals and junk).

Oversite Committee – Terry Gates reported that fire company is putting \$250,000.00 in an interest bearing account until it is needed. Fire company had a successful chicken wing and fries fund raiser. Fire company continues to explore the Volunteer Fire Fighter Tax Credit program. It was discussed that neighboring municipalities should be involved. Possibly have the program in place for 2024.

Solicitor – Solicitor Beard shared that a mobile home park owner would like to add 2 more mobile homes to the Open Space area of his mobile home park. Boggs Township would need to amend the Zoning Ordinance to allow the additional

mobile homes. The supervisors felt that the Open Space was required when the mobile home park was built and decided not to amend the Zoning Ordinance.
